cordially invites you to their back-to-back licensed hunt tests September 6 & 7, 2008 at the beautiful Bosque del Apache National Wildlife Refuge. Any retriever or versatile gun dog may participate. Please come and join us.

PLEASE BRING YOUR DUCK STAMP. This facility is

free to our club if each vehicle has in their possession a Duck Stamp.

ENTRIES: Entries must be received no later than 5:00pm August 30, 2008 to be listed in the catalog. Entries will be accepted via regular US mail delivery. If entry is sent express or overnight mail, make sure that a signature is NOT required for delivery. If you wish confirmation of your entry, please send a stamped, self-addressed envelope or post card. Entries will be accepted up to the day of the hunt if there is still room in your category.

SCRATCH POLICY: There will be no refunds for "No Shows".. Only injuries and females in season (which are not allowed on the test ground) will be entitled to a refund with a written verification signed by a veterinarian.

CHECK IN: Check in will start at 7:00am both Saturday and Sunday at a pull off on the main road into Bosque del Apache (watch for RHRC signs). The handlers meeting will be at 7:30am and the hunt will begin shortly thereafter.

CLOTHING AND GEAR: All participants must wear hunting attire appropriate for a New Mexico duck/goose/dove hunt. Hip boots and/or waders and a duck call may be required in all levels. Please come prepared for rain and **sun** as our NM weather is ever changing. Bring bug spray, sunscreen and plenty of water for yourself and your dogs.

LUNCH WILL NOT be provided. Please plan on bringing your lunch, as there are no restaurants in the immediate vicinity

SATURDAY NIGHT TAILGATE SOCIAL: Everyone is invited to the Social on Saturday night, which will be held at the Hunt Test Headquarters in Socorro near the pool area. **We request you let us know your party size with your entry so that appropriate quantities of food can be available..**

ACCOMMODATIONS: Hunt Test Headquarters will be Motel 6 located at 807 Hwy 85 Socorro, NM 575-835-4300. If you identify yourself as being with Roadrunner HRC you will receive special rates. Dogs are permitted but please respect the grounds. Other motels are also available in Socorro.

RV spaces with full hookups are available at:

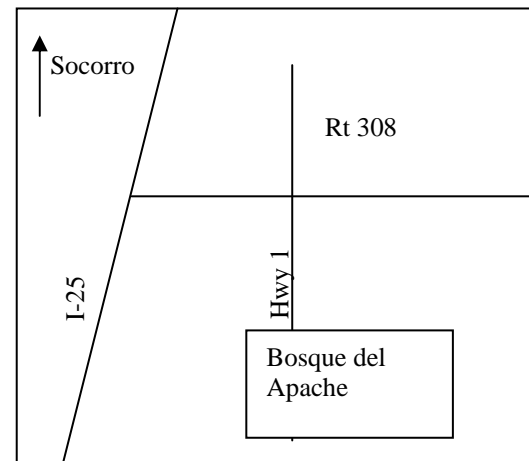
Bosque Birdwatcher's Park, 575-835-1366. Located 5 miles north of the test site on the west side of the road.

HUNT GROUNDS: The hunt will be on the grounds of the Bosque del Apache National Wildlife Refuge, NM. The refuge is one of the most spectacular wildlife refuges in America. We are very fortunate to have use of this beautiful facility and wish to thank the US Fish & Wildlife Service for making this possible. Wildlife disturbance is a key issue on the refuge and must be minimized at all costs. Please treat the grounds with respect and obey all regulations.

PLEASE BRING YOUR DUCK STAMP. This facility is free to our club if each vehicle has in their possession a Duck Stamp.

Directions: From Albuquerque ---take I-25 south to San Antonio, exit 139. Take Route 380 east for 0.5 miles, then State Hwy 1 south 8 miles to the refuge. From the south ---take I-25 north to San Marcial, exit 124, then north to State Hwy 1 for 9 miles to the refuge.
